OFFICE HOURS: Please note that Krissy is on annual leave this week. She will return to the office Monday 8th April.

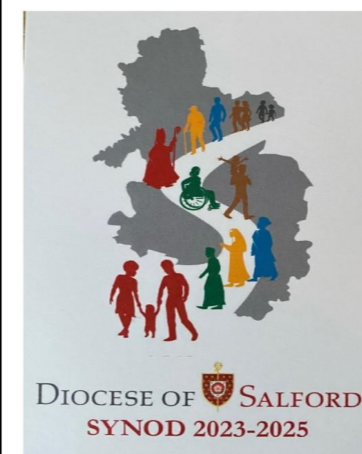
EASTER RAFFLE: raised £372. Thank you to all who contributed.
